Articles in List "A" must be obtained from school when required. Those in List "B" may be obtained at school if necessary, but should be brought from home if possible. Those in List "C" must be brought from home. No clothes should be sent to school other than those on the list.

ALL ARTICLES must be marked OT followed by the boy's school number. Cash's tapes are provided from school and a further supply can always be obtained from the Bursar. It is not necessary to mark the articles with the boy's name. Articles should be marked in the following places:- At the inside back of neck where possible; inside back of waist of trousers and shorts; outside top front of pants; inside back top of socks and stockings; raincoat belts should be marked inside; boots/shoes should be marked inside at side with ink and the number in small nails underneath if possible; handkerchiefs and towels should be marked in the corner; bath towels should have a flat loop sewn in the middle of one side; each sock and stocking must have loop of tape 3" long (made from 6" tape), sewn inside at top in order they may be looped together in pairs when sent to laundry. It is extremely difficult to keep up to date with the boys' mending so will parents please be aware of this.
