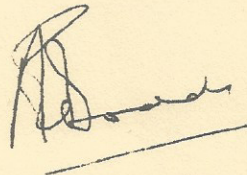

I wish to draw the attention of boys and parents to the following rule :

"A boy must ~~never~~ ride another boy's bicycle without the owner's permission and a boy without a bicycle of his own at school must never borrow one."

It follows from this that, if a boy does not bring a bicycle to school , he should never ride one, and any boy who breaks this rule will be severely punished.
