Dear Sir or Madam,

SWEETS and POCKET-MONEY. As you know, in order that there should not be differences of opportunity for boys while in the school, our rules limit pocket-money to a minimum of 1s/6d. and a maximum of 2s/6d. This is intended to cover a boy's expenditure on sweets. Though as long as sweets are rationed, I have raised no objection to a parent sending some of his or her ration to a son at school, it is clearly unfair that a parent should buy the son's ration at home and send it to him. This latter practice results in a boy having an effective pocket-money allowance more than the other boys. It also removes part of the effect of being on the Headmaster's list for a boy who is indisciplined.

In future, therefore, boys must bring back with them to school their personal points.
